IMPORTANT INFORMATION*To ensure fair and honest election results, I certify that:*

1. I agree not to (a) hold the office of or run as a candidate for any elective public or political party office or any other office created under the Constitution or Laws of the State; (b) use my official authority as an election judge for the purpose of influencing or affecting the results of an election; or (c) serve as a campaign manager for a candidate or as the treasurer for a campaign finance entity while performing election judge duties during early voting or on election day.
2. As an election judge I will arrive to my polling place at the assigned time. I will not leave the polling place, for any reason, at any time during early voting or Election Day while the polls are open.
3. I agree to be courteous, respectful and assist all voters regardless of national origin, race, creed, gender, age, physical challenge, or proficiency in the English language.
4. I am prepared to fulfill my responsibility to conduct the election according to federal, state, and local election laws.
5. I agree not to take out or use my personal cell phone at any time while the polls are open unless I am a Chief Judge or Election Field Support in which case, I am permitted to use my personal cell phone to communicate with the Board of Elections. I agree not to bring or use any electronic devices at any time in the polls. (Excludes medical devices.)
6. I understand I cannot bring children and/or pets to training or to the polls on Election Day.
7. I understand if I am under 18 years of age, I must have a parent or guardian's permission to be an election judge.
