Ms. Berry reported that a request to get the 2020 and 2022 EL45A results report was submitted. It was a statewide request that the State Board of Elections has fulfilled. In response to a question, Ms. Berry stated that there are no outstanding PIA requests.

Voter Registration

Ms. Berry stated that the monthly statistical reports are available on our website. The link to the reports is https://elections.carrollcountymd.gov/monthlyStats.aspx.

Electronic Registration Information Center (ERIC) reports were completed in early February.

Brett Paradise has been hired by the State Board of Elections (SBE) as the new Director of Voter Registration.

Preparations for the municipal elections has begun. The close of registration dates are in April and election days will be held in May. Voter notification cards will be mailed to voters who live in several municipalities where the polling place was changed.

Election Judges

Ms. Berry reported that a post-election survey was sent to the election judges who served during the 2022 elections. Their responses helped staff develop lessons learned and best practices in preparation from the 2024 elections.

Election judges were hired to help with the manual audit that occurred.

IT/Warehouse

Ms. Berry stated that Post Election Maintenance (PEM) has begun on the scanning units, ballot marking devices, voting booths, and electronic pollbooks.

The website has been updated to include current elected officials, information about the 2024 elections, and information about the municipal elections. In response to a question, Ms. Perrone explained the layout of the information and the disclosure notice at the top of the page stating that the Carroll County Board of Elections does not oversee any municipal election.

Preparations have begun for the new electronic pollbook deployment which is expected in June. The current electronic pollbook cases will likely be used for storage and polling place deployment.

SBE will be procuring a new voting system to be used beginning in the 2026 elections and a new voter registration database to be used beginning in the 2028 election.
